5:45 PM - Wait list teams accepted if space is available

6:00 PM - Event begins

REGISTER:

- A maximum of 10 (ten) teams can enter on a first-come-first-served basis. In the event all ten team slots are filled, a Wait List will be created with teams listed in the order in which their registration is received.
- All teams must submit completed registration requirements by July 1st
- No cost for registration.
- Teams shall consist of four (4) persons.
- Choose a clever team name (that is family friendly and appropriate).
- Only the first ten (10) teams submitting completed registration by July 1st will receive one (1) free admission ticket for each team member on the day of the event.
 - Parking is not included.
 - Use of the fair shuttle system is encouraged.
- Unregistered teams will be accepted on the Wait List at Uncle Leo's Barn between 5:00 PM – 5:30 PM on the day of the event. These teams will be seated in the order of registration on a space available basis.
- Members of Uncle Leo's Barn family and staff and CAPCA members are not eligible as contestants in this event.

CHECK-IN, LATE ARRIVAL & WAIT LIST:

- Registered teams must check in at the contest location in the seating area behind Uncle Leo's Barn at 5:30 PM.
- All team members must be present at check-in and sign hard copy of team registration.
- At 5:45 PM any team not checked in, with all team members present, and registration form completed, will forfeit their registration to teams on the Wait List.

No alcoholic beverages at the team tables.

PHONES, EARBUDS and use of other Electronic Devices is prohibited:

- Team members' phones will be required to be set to silent mode and placed face down on the table in front of each member. Earbuds and any other electronic device shall not be on or used by any team member. **Any team using a cell phone, earbuds or other "smart"/electronic device for any purpose during the competition will be disqualified.** It is recommended that players turn off their phones/electronic devices during the competition.
- Communication with friends, family and audience members during question-and-answer session is prohibited and is also grounds for disqualification. Disqualified teams will be notified when the final answer sheet is collected and no score will be announced.

Questions will pertain to agricultural practices, crops and commodities in Ventura County, California and the U.S. as outlined by the USDA, CDFA, Fairs & Expositions, Farm Bureau, University of California Cooperative Extension and Ventura Co.
